


WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU ARE EXPECTING ... A WALL BED

BEFORE YOU PLACE YOUR ORDER, MEASURE AND ASSESS THE SPACE ACCURATELY

Yes, your wall bed is about to change your life – and we are here to make sure that everything goes smoothly.



Measure Carefully

Have you measured the space carefully to make sure that the furniture is ordered correctly, and it will not interfere with doors, windows, vents, etc.?

- Measurements should be taken from baseboard-to-baseboard.
- Generally, there will always be a small gap between the wall and the furniture. If you want your installation to extend completely from wall to wall, let your Sales & Design Associate know, as these installations require special consideration, including additional materials and custom millwork services which are not included in a typical installation.
- Don't forget to measure ceiling and soffit heights.
- Confirm that your floor is reasonably level.

Assess the Space

If you are within one of our delivery areas and your project requires a site visit, the information below will be gathered by the team member performing the site visit. Otherwise, please take note of the following:

- Determine if your floor will be a hard surface or carpet. This is important information that can help determine which wall bed model is right for you.
- Take note of the location of wall switches and electrical outlets, and make sure that your Sales & Design Consultant has this information before placing your order.

Confirm that there is clear access to the room where the furniture will be installed:

- Is your home accessible by a large truck?
- The largest element of the wall bed is the bed base. If there are staircases or elevators en route to the installation site, are they large enough to accommodate a box spring? If so, the bed base will fit. If not, don't worry! We have a split bed base option when access is limited – just talk to your Sales & Design Associate.

(Note that this is just for measurement purposes – our wall beds feature an integrated sprung base, eliminating the need for a box spring)
